

SCOR-IT WEB SITE PROJECT SEPTEMBER 2008
Purse & Card

Using a double-sided print 12 x 12 is best since you can see inside the purse, and a medium weight will give best results.

STEP 1

Score 1" from one edge; and 1" again from opposite edge: (photo 1)



STEP 2

Score 3-1/2" from remaining two edges: (photo 2)



STEP 3

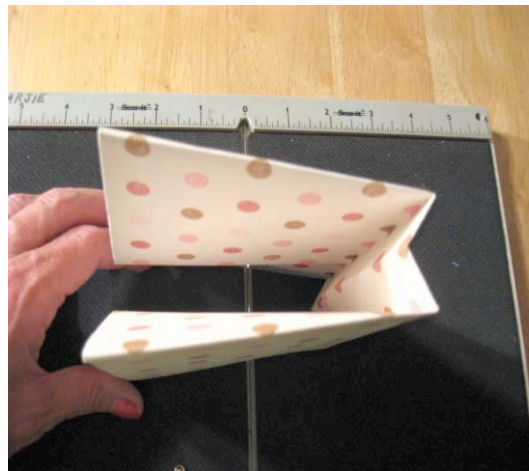
Fold and crease score lines made so far.

With the 1" fold edges lined up with the 5" marks of the ruler, score the center through the folded layers, as shown. (photo 3)



STEP 4

Flip the piece over and position on ruler for making two score lines on either side of the center score line, 1" from the center score line. (photos 4a, 4b)



STEP 5

Open to apply adhesive along the 1" folds. (photo 5)



STEP 6

Fold into thirds to apply adhesive on the inside. (Apply to BOTH edges of both flaps)

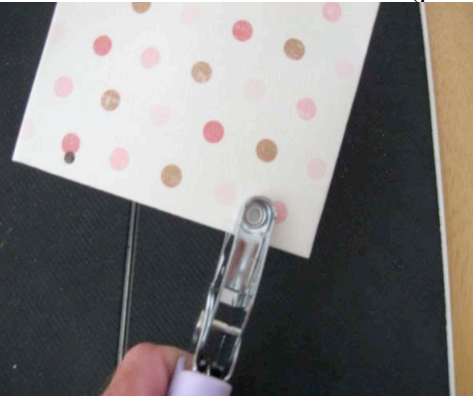
STEP 7

Apply adhesive on the side with the 'mountain' in the center, as wide and as deep into the purse as shown by the fingers in the photo, a 'rectangle' where the two purse sections will join permanently. (photos 7a, 7b)



STEP 8

Measure 1" from both side edges, appx. 1/2" from purse top opening; make a pencil mark.
Punch 1/8" diameter holes (two). Repeat on other side for total of 4 holes. (photos 8a, 8b)



STEP 9

Complete the purse design with ribbon handles and embellishment. (photo 9)



Add a matching card to slip inside to complete.
