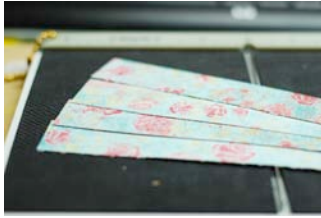


Step by step instructions for Handmade Domino Container:

1. Cut 3 double sided pattern papers into 6x1 inch strips.



2. Score lines at every $\frac{1}{2}$ inch (total of 10 scored lines) with the 3 strips.



3. Cut additional 5 (6x1 inch) strips and divide into half. Cut and score each half at every $\frac{1}{2}$ inch (total of 5 scored lines).



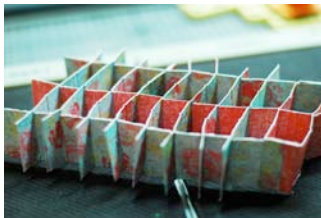
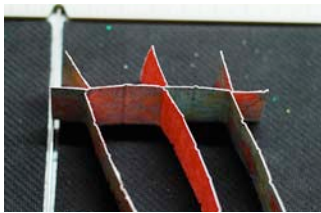
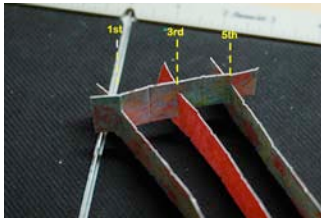
4. Cut each 6 inch strip using your scissor 0.75 inch along the scored lines from the top. You will cut 10 times on each strip.



5. Cut each 3 inch strip halfway starting from the bottom to the top on the 1st, 3rd and 5th scored lines.

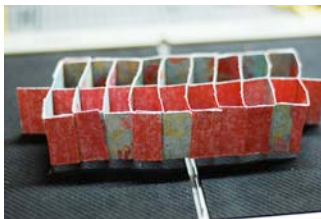
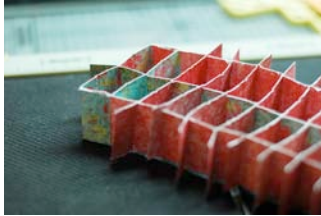
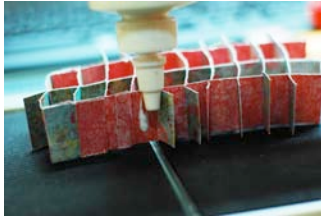


6. Line the 3 strips (6 inch) vertically and side by side with each other. Appose each 3 inch strip perpendicularly to the 6 inch strip continuously until all the strips (total of 10) are locked in place. You will create 18 squared compartments in 2 rows here.



7. Remember that the 3 inch strips has cut areas on the 1st, 3rd and 5th scored lines. You just have to lock these areas onto the 6 inch strips to be able to create compartments.

8. Adhere all flaps to its sides except for the 2 middle flaps on the anterior and posterior edge.



9. Paint the sides with metallic gold and sprinkle with Beadazzles.



10. Measure hamby transparency 4.75x2.25 inch to serve as base.



11. Use crop-a-dile to punch hole and insert eyelet and ribbon.
